Local Community Cafes:

Meets six times per school year for 1 ½-2 hours

No Agenda ~ conversations center around previous harvest (i.e., the last conversation)

Planned and led by Parents and/or Neighborhood Residents

In person ~ childcare, dinner, interpreters offered

Cafes occur within school neighborhoods
